Each Incorrect Answer: -1 Mark

BITSAT Exam Pattern - Highlights

- There is no time limit for individual parts of BITSAT. The candidate can go back and change any of his/her answers among the 130 questions.
- If a candidate answers all the 130 questions (without skipping any question), the candidate will have an option of attempting 12 (twelve) extra questions, if there is still time left. These extra questions will be from Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics/Biology only; four questions from each part. Further, once the candidate has opted for extra questions, he/she cannot go back for correction of any of the earlier answered 130 questions.
- The questions asked in the BITSAT paper will be designed in a way that a good student will be able to answer 130 questions in 180 minutes. The extra questions (a maximum of 12) will give a chance to highly meritorious candidates to score higher. However, candidates should keep in mind the fact that there is negative marking for wrong answers and any attempt to answer the questions by pure guessing of the answers is not likely to have any advantage, but may result in a reduction in the total score.
- Candidates will also be able to check the score in online mode a day after the examination. Print out of the scores can also be taken.

BITSAT Syllabus

Candidates must check the <u>BITSAT exam syllabus</u> before starting their preparation. The syllabus of BITSAT will include the subject like Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, English and Logical Reasoning. Understanding the BITSAT syllabus clearly will help candidates to know what is required to study to secure higher scores in the BITSAT exam.

BITSAT Mock Test

In order to have a better understanding of the exam pattern of BITSAT, students are advised to attempt a mock test. The <u>BITSAT mock test</u> is designed in a pattern similar to the actual examination. Previous year's papers can also be treated as <u>BITSAT sample paper</u> to evaluate the exam preparation.

The Chemistry paper in BITSAT will have a total of 30 questions.
