MHT CET Exam Pattern - State CET cell, Maharashtra has released the MHT CET exam pattern at cetcell.mahacet.org. The exam pattern of MHT CET includes details like exam mode, sections, duration, type of questions, total marks, marking scheme, and more. The MHT CET exam will be conducted as a computer-based test

As per the MHT CET paper pattern, there will be two sections in the exam - Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics of 100 marks each. The MHT CET questions will be prepared on the basis of the Class 11th and 12th syllabus of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education. The MHT CET is a computer-based test for admission to B. Tech and other courses in the participating institutes of Maharashtra. MHT CET Exam Pattern - Key Points

- MHT CET will be conducted as a computer-based exam of 3 hours.
- The exam will have two sections- Physics & Chemistry and Mathematics.
- It must be noted that for the first 90 minutes, only section 1 i.e., Physics & Chemistry will
 be active and after the completion of 90 minutes, the section will be automatically closed.
 After this, candidates will have to attempt the mathematics section in the next 90 minutes.
- It means candidates will not be allowed to switch between sections.
- MHT CET will have multiple choice questions having 4 options out of which only one alternative/answer will be correct.
- There is no negative marking in the MHT CET exam.
- MHT CET question paper will be prepared on the basis of the syllabus of the Maharashtra
 State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education.
- Approximately, 20% weightage will be given to the 11th standard syllabus and 80% to the
 12th standard syllabus while setting the question paper.
- Candidates are advised to choose the medium/language of the exam carefully while submitting the MHT CET application form as the language selected at that time cannot be changed later.

MHT CET Syllabus

The authorities have released the MHT CET syllabus along with the official notification. As mentioned above, questions in MHT CET will be prepared on the basis of the Class 11th and 12th Syllabus. Candidates will have to focus on the entire syllabus of Class 12th for their MHT CET preparation while only some topics will be included from the Class 11th syllabus. Candidates must understand the MHT CET syllabus beforehand in order to study the right topics for the exam.

Frequently Asked Question (FAQs) - MHT CET Exam Pattern - Check Marking Scheme, Duration, Exam Mode

Question: How many sections will MHT CET have?

Answer:

MHT CET will consist of two sections - Mathematics and Physics & Chemistry.

Question: What will be the difficulty level of MHT CET?

Answer:

The difficulty level of the mathematics section will be at par with the JEE Main exam. However, for Physics and Chemistry, the difficulty level will be at par with NEET.

Question: What is the weightage of Class 11th and 12th syllabus in MHT CET?

Answer:

As per the MHT CET syllabus, 20% weightage will be given to Class 11th syllabus and 80% to Class 12th syllabus while setting the MHT CET question paper.

Question: What will be the total duration of MHT CET?

Answer:

The total time duration of MHT CET will be 180 minutes (90 minutes for each paper).


Question: What is the marking scheme of MHT CET?

Answer:

Candidates will be allotted 2 marks for each correct answer in Mathematics section. On the other hand, in the Physics and Chemistry section, 1 mark will be awarded for each correct answer. In addition to this, there will be no negative marking in MHT CET exam.
