

## AIIMS Overview

All India Institutes of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) are a group of autonomous public medical colleges in India. They are considered among the most prestigious medical institutions in the country.

## Courses Offered

- MBBS: The most popular course offered by AIIMS, with a duration of 5.5 years, including a one-year internship.
- MD/MS: Postgraduate courses with a duration of 3 years.
- DM/M.Ch: Super-specialty courses with a duration of 3-6 years.
- (link unavailable) Nursing: A 4-year undergraduate course.
- (link unavailable) Nursing: A 2-year postgraduate course.
- PhD: Doctoral programs in various disciplines.

## Eligibility Criteria

- MBBS: Candidates must have passed 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology, and English, with a minimum aggregate of 50-60% marks, depending on the AIIMS institute. They must also be at least 17 years old as of December 31 of the admission year.
- MD/MS: Candidates must have an MBBS degree with a minimum of 55% marks.
- DM/M.Ch: Candidates must have a postgraduate degree in the relevant discipline.

## Admission Process

- MBBS: Admissions are based on NEET UG scores, followed by counselling conducted by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC).
- MD/MS: Admissions are based on INI-CET scores, followed by counselling.
- DM/M.Ch: Admissions are based on INI-SS scores, followed by counselling.
